Volunteers needed in the North West area -Derry City, Limavady and Strabane to support victims of crime.

Volunteers for the charity provide support in two areas. Witness Service volunteers are located within the courts providing support to victims and witnesses as their cases come to trial, accompanying them into court, advocating on their behalf and conducting pre-trial court visits.

Community Service volunteers meet with victims shortly after a crime has been committed and provide emotional support and advice to help them through this period. They are located at the Victim Support NI Hub in the Embassy Building, as well as in outreach centres across Northern Ireland.

The charity also received the nationwide quality standard 'Investing in Volunteers' Award in June 2017. Investing in Volunteers aims to improve the quality of the volunteering experience for all volunteers, and demonstrates that Victim Support NI values the enormous contribution made by their volunteers.



Group Services in Castlederg inform, educate, support and provide structured activities for attendees in a relaxed group setting. We have an opening for a volunteer to help provide support to the Group Leader with room set-up, recording attendees, talking to carers of people living with dementia, preparing and distributing refreshments and encouraging group participation.

No specific qualifications are needed and this role will suit you if you have an interest in supporting people, have good listening and communication skills, and enjoy meeting new people.

The Group meet the third Wednesday of each month from 7.00pm - 8.30pm in Castlederg.



Conservation Volunteer: 1-2 days per month to carry out a wide range of practical conservation tasks throughout the Faughan Valley.

This volunteer role will contribute towards the Woodland Trust's strategy of preserving, growing, maintaining and restoring woods and trees across the UK. As a Conservation Volunteer, you make a difference by being our eyes and ears on the ground, and feeding back any issues to the volunteer manager.

Environment Monitor Volunteer: Surveys take place throughout the year; volunteers giving 4-6 days per year would be appreciated

The Environment Monitor role is primarily a seasonal role to support the development of a major landscape-scale woodland project across the Faughan Valley. Surveys are varied, covering anything from generic hedgerow, woodland or habitat surveys to more specific; bat, lizard or frog orchid surveys.

Youth Services Volunteers: Extern is looking for committed volunteers to help with their projects with children & young people across the local area from Strabane to Limavady, Derry/Londonderry City-side and Waterside.

Community Crisis Intervention Service Volunteers: They are also seeking volunteers to assist with their new Community Crisis intervention service providing support for anyone experiencing situational or emotional crisis.



Beyond the Walls is a project delivering Reading Rooms sessions to young people in the criminal justice system.

Reading Rooms sessions run over 12 weeks and last one hour facilitated by a volunteer.

Volunteers receive accredited training in facilitation skills for shared reading (OCN Level 2), safeguarding children and adults at risk and ongoing support from staff and peers at regular volunteer events.
